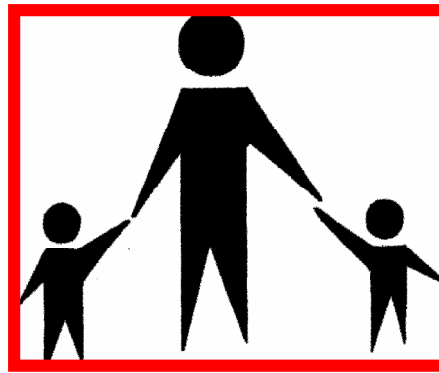

## ***Autism Assistance Team***

This team is comprised of a group of highly trained individuals from a variety of disciplines who observe the student in a variety of environments in the school setting or at home and

provide recommendations as well as examples of visual supports, social stories and other social supports and ongoing ideas for accommodations and modifications.

The Autism Assistance Project is supported through the TMCSEA IDEA Flow Through Grant and sponsored by the Illinois Autism/Pervasive Developmental Disorder Training and Technological Assistance Project.

In addition to the home and/or school consultation, the Autism Assistance Team can also provide:

- staff development training for any school personnel working with a child on the Autism Spectrum
- ADOS/ADI-R evaluations
