## ***Childhood Apraxia of Speech: Background Information & Evidence-Based Intervention***

This presentation will discuss diagnostic indicators for differentiating CAS from other speech and language disorders. Research evidence in intervention for children with CAS will be evaluated. Cognitive motor-based principles, goals, and protocols will be reviewed. Using videotaped exhibitions, profiles of children with moderate and severe CAS will be presented. Participants will transcribe the speech of a child with CAS, select goals for several different children with CAS, and practice intervention techniques.
