



# Young Children & Childhood Apraxia of Speech Assessment & Treatment

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A recent survey collected by Bjorem Speech indicated that over 88% of SLP's consider themselves novice/still learning in the area of CAS. During this course we will outline the characteristics of CAS and how they differentiate from other speech disorders and how that impacts a differential diagnosis. We will walk through the evaluation process, learn how to choose targets and write goals that support a motor planning speech disorder. We learn about the different treatment approaches available for CAS and review the Principles of Motor Learning. Multi-sensory cueing strategies will be discussed as well as how to incorporate cueing into therapy.
