



## Functional Behavior Assessment - Behavior Intervention Plan (FBA-BIP) Presented by Midwest PBIS

Is your student problem solving team struggling to developing individual student plans that are effective? Come to this training to learn about using function of behavior to guide their individual student plans. These sessions will focus specifically on the processes and tools needed to assist coaches, facilitators and problem-solving teams in planning, implementing, and evaluating FBA-BIP.

### Who Should Participate:

- District/building based coaches specifically focused on supporting Tier 2 and/or Tier 3 interventions
- Problem Solving Team members: individuals who will help in the development of behavior intervention plans. (administrators, teachers, paraprofessionals, one-on-one aides)
- Potential FBA-BIP facilitators: (i.e. counselors, social workers, school psychologists, behavior specialists, special education personnel, community partners, etc.)

### Participants can expect to leave being able to:

- Identify when an FBA-BIP is necessary
- Identify the essential systems needed for an effective FBA-BIP process
- Identify the steps for conducting an effective FBA, including data to determine maintaining function of behavior
- Understand the critical components of function-based BIPs
- Develop evaluation plans that are efficient and effective

*All participants will register for the entire series including two training days followed by technical assistance webinars. The webinars are specifically focused on building skills of coaches and facilitators to be able to write technically sound FBA-BIPs.*
