Total of 75 responses as of 12/12/2012.

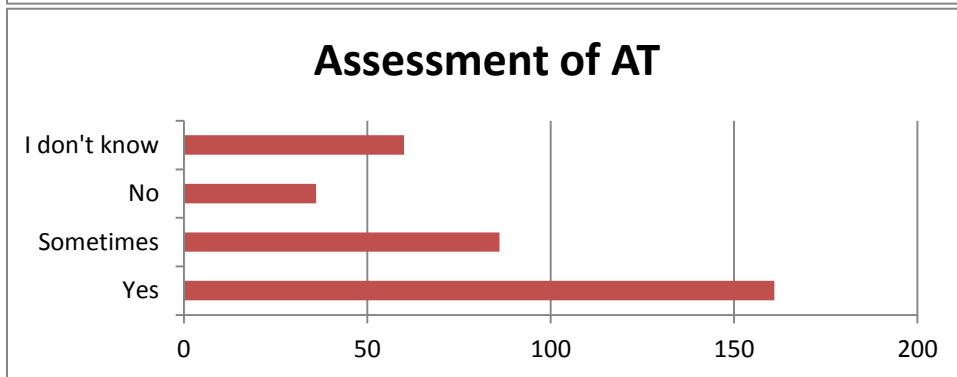
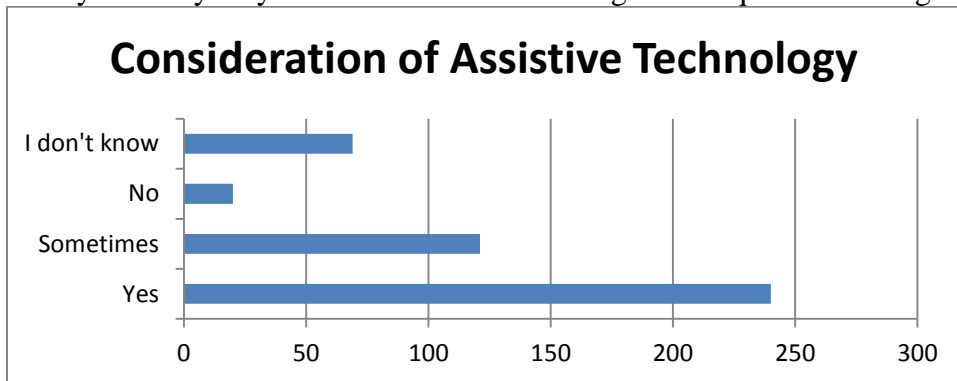
41% of the districts had at least one person respond.

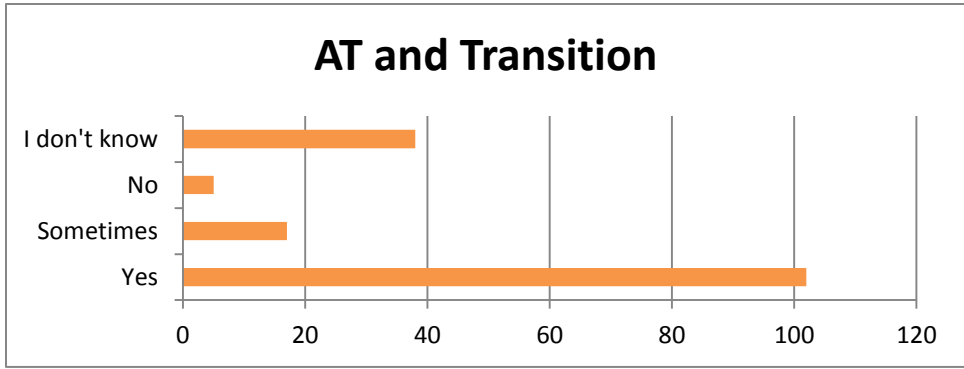
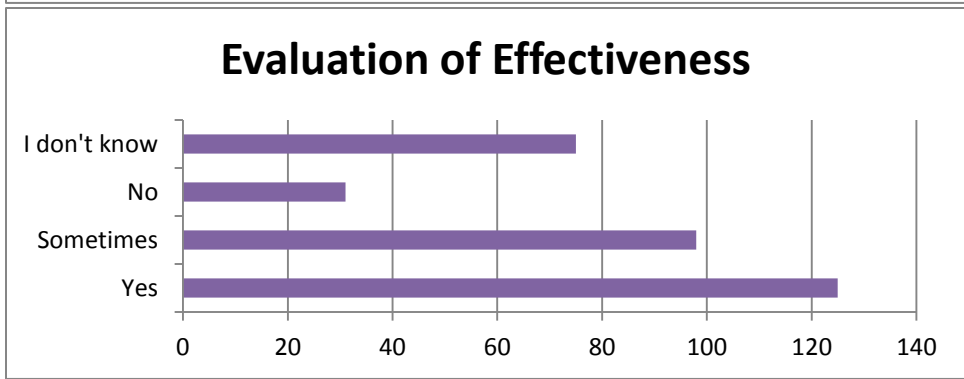
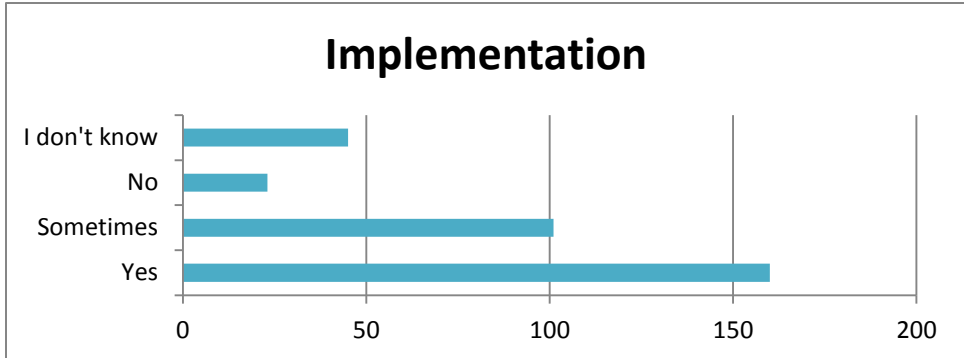
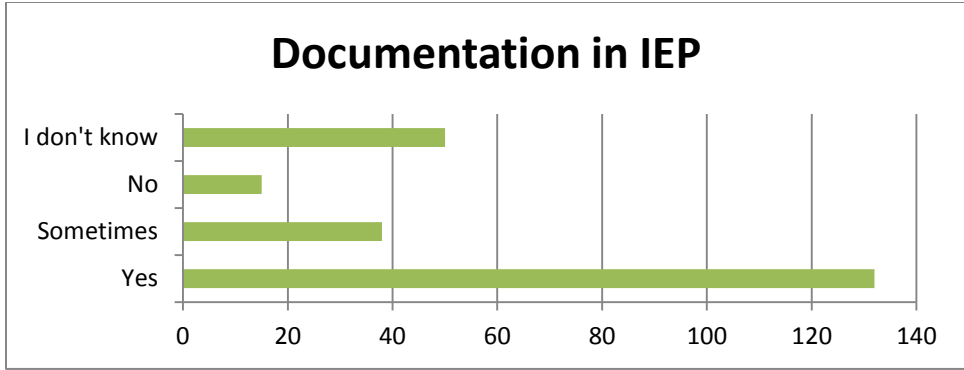
### Breakdown of who responded:

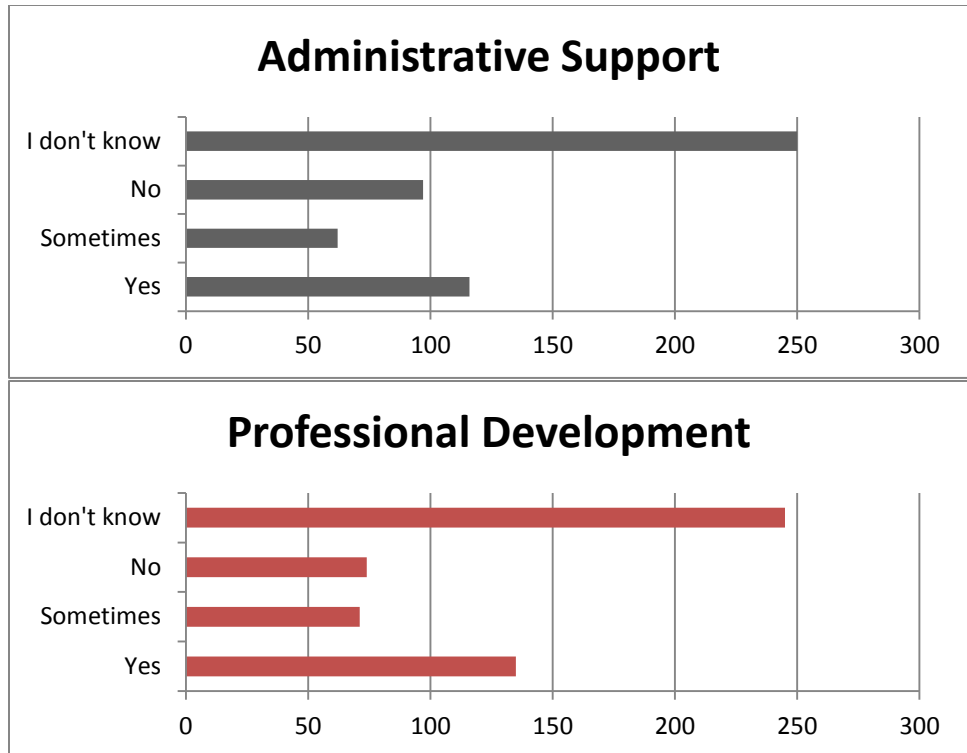
- 9% Administrators
