

# Summer Camp, Respite, and Childcare Resources

## **Pekin Park District and Illinois River Valley Special Recreation Association**

- Child must be a resident of Tazewell or Woodford County
- Camp hours are 7:00am-5:30pm, Monday through Friday
- Staff will help students for 1-2 hours of learning time
- Call the Pekin Park District or Illinois River Valley Special Recreation Association

- Open to children ages 6-13
- Grants are available to low income families with parents working 6 or more hours a day
- Households must be at or below the 30 day gross income listed below.
  - Two in household 2, 873
  - 3 in household 3,620
  - 4 in household 4,367
  - 5 in household 5,113
  - 6 in the household 5,860
  - 7 in household 6,607

## **Division of Rehabilitation Services (DHS)**

- Families who would like someone they identify to provide respite in their home can contact DHS to set up payment to an individual who provides respite for a child. The family should call and leave a message. They will return the phone call as they are working remotely.
- We have a list of 5 potential respite providers who also work at Schramm compiled.
- We can help the family identify someone to provide respite services, and they can see if they are eligible for payment through DHS.
- In addition to respite services, the family could also apply for a personal assistant, maintenance home health, assistive equipment, and environmental modification for their child.
- They can also apply online with this link to the referral form. It is an online fillable form which parents can complete and submit to request help online.
